

04 NIGHTS / 05 DAYS INCENTIVE PACKAGE in Sri Lanka

Day 01

Arrival, Welcome by a Representative of Lanka Sportreizen by garlanding and transfer to Hotel- Negombo **(A bottle of 500ML mineral water offered in the coach as the welcome gesture)**

From the entrance to the Hotel, the group will be escorted by a Group of Cultural Dancers & Drummers, then the Oil Lamp will be lit by a few participants of the Group as per traditions prior to the welcome drinks being offered.

Lunch at Hotel

Evening undertake a **Boat Cruise** in the Muthurajawela Nature Reserve - one single continuous coastal wetland. Twice daily the high tide brings seawater into the wetland, while fresh water from a watershed of 720 km² is discharged at the junction of the lagoon and the marsh. Continuous mixing of these two waters has led to a brackish ecosystem, with high productivity and high biological diversity. Many species of fish, shrimps and crabs spend a part of their life in the shelter of mangroves and sea-grass beds. Both the marsh and the lagoon house numerous plant and animal species, of which many are rare or endemic. The protected estuarine crocodile reproduces here, large numbers of migratory birds come here for nestling and feeding too.

Dinner & Overnight at a Hotel in Negombo

Day 02

After breakfast at Hotel, leave for Kandy –The Hill Capital of Sri Lanka and the last kingdom of Sri Lanka before falling to the British in 1815 AD.

At Mawenella, get off and **start hiking** to reach the summit of the Uthuwankanda - the watch point used by "Sura Saradiel" – "local Robin Hood" to track the Mail Coaches proceeding along the Kandy Road with lots of valuables including payrolls of the British Planters - which were later robbed when they reached this area by "Sardiel" who in turn gave the money away to the poor people in the area. (2 hours)

Picnic Lunch

Have a rest - enjoy the scenic beauty of the surrounding area and start the descending hike through villages, paddy fields Rubber/Coconut Plantations etc to reach Pinnawela. (about 2 hours).

Evening visit the Elephant Orphanage- Pinnawala - to enjoy seeing the largest herd of domestic elephants in Sri Lanka with animals of all ages including babies who are still being fed by bottle at 1700 hrs and bathing them in the river from 1400 -1600 hrs. **(Feeding & bathing depending on the time factor)**

Special Dinner (No Drinks) with the Cultural Performances by traditional Kandyan Dancers and Drummers.

Overnight at a Hotel in Kandy

Day 03

After breakfast at Hotel, **by Tuk Tuk** undertake a City Tour of Kandy including the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, Upper Lake Drive, Kandy Lake area and the Royal Botanical Gardens which is one of the best of its kind in Asia with more than 5000 species of Flora (Inside the garden on foot).

Drop off at **The Restaurant –Kandy for Lunch.**

Then transfer to Hotel in coach(s) after visiting a Gem Museum for free time.

Overnight at a Hotel in Kandy

Day 04

After breakfast at Hotel, transfer to Hotel in Colombo.

En route visit a Spice Garden

Lunch in a Restaurant – Colombo

Then undertake a City Tour of Colombo including a Buddhist Temple, a Hindu Kovil, Town Hall, BMICH, Galle Face Green, Old Parliament and Pettah and Fort Bazaar area and Shopping at Odel Unlimited and House of Fashion etc..

01 Hour - Cocktail with free flow of local Beer, Soft Drinks, Local Spirits with two / three Canapés.

Gala Dinner (European Style) with Music at Hotel.

Overnight at a Hotel in Colombo

Day 05

After breakfast at Hotel, free time till departure

Transfer to Airport for departure.
