



### Day 01 –

Arrival by ..... at .....Hrs. Welcome by a Representative of Lanka Sportreizen by garlanding and transfer to Hotel– Negombo.

(A bottle of 500ML mineral water offered in the coach as the welcome gesture )

From the entrance to the Hotel, the group will be escorted by a Group of Cultural Dancers & Drummers then the Oil Lamp will be lit by a few participants of the Group as per traditions prior to the welcome drinks being offered.

### **Lunch at Hotel**

Evening undertake a **Boat Cruise** in the Muthurajawela Nature Reserve – one single continuous coastal wetland. Twice daily the high tide brings seawater into the wetland, while fresh water from a watershed of 720 km<sup>2</sup> is discharged at the junction of the lagoon and the marsh. Continuous mixing of these two waters has led to a brackish ecosystem, with high productivity and high biological diversity. Many species of fish, shrimps and crabs spend a part of their life in the shelter of mangroves and sea-grass beds. Both the marsh and the lagoon house numerous plant and animal species, of which many are rare or endemic. The protected estuarine crocodile reproduces here, large numbers of migratory birds come here for nestling and feeding too.

**Dinner & Overnight at Browns Beach Hotel /Pegasus Reef Hotel ( Wattala ) or Similar – Negombo**

### Day 02 –

After breakfast at Hotel , leave for Sigiriya / Dambulla via Pinnawala.

Evening visit the Elephant Orphanage– Pinnawala – to enjoy seeing the largest herd of domestic elephants in Sri Lanka with animals of all ages including babies who are still being fed by bottles **at 0915 hrs** OR bathing them in the river from 1000 –1200 noon .( **Feeding & bathing depending on the time factor** ).

**Lunch in a Restaurant / Hotel – Kurunegala / Dambulla**

Afternoon **climb the Sigiriya Rock Fortress** –World Heritage Site, which was a Royal Citadel for more than 20 years in 05th Century AD, widely considered as the 08<sup>th</sup> Wonder of the modern world and visit a Batik Making Factory.

**Overnight at Sigiriya Village Hotel / Amaya Lake or Similar – Sigiriya / Dambulla**

## Day 03 –

After early breakfast at Hotel , proceed to Minneriya National Park and undertake a **Jeep Safari** for spotting herds of wild Elephants and other wildlife.

On the way back to Hotel enjoy an **Elephant Back Ride** in the Habarana area.

**Lunch at Hotel .**

After lunch leave for Kandy –The Hill Capital of Sri Lanka and the last kingdom of Sri Lanka before falling to the British in 1815 AD.

En route visit a Spice Garden in Matale and enjoy a Herbal Massage Treatment .



**Special Dinner ( no drinks ) with the Cultural Performances by traditional Kandyan Dancers and Drummers.**

**Dinner & Overnight at Mahaweli Reach Hotel / Amaya Hills or Similar – Kandy**

## Day 04 –

After breakfast at Hotel , **by Tuk Tuks** undertake a City Tour of Kandy including the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, Upper Lake Drive , Kandy Lake area and the Royal Botanical Gardens which is one of the best of its kind in Asia with more than 5000 species of Flora (Inside the garden on foot ).

**Lunch at a Restaurant –Kandy**

Then transfer to Hotel in coach/es after visiting a Gem Museum for free time.

**Dinner & Overnight at Mahaweli Reach Hotel / Amaya Hills or Similar – Kandy**

## Day 05 –

After breakfast at Hotel , transfer to Hotel in Colombo.

En route visit the Giragama Tea Plantation and the Factory to witness the manufacturing process of world famous “Ceylon Tea” and taste a pure unblended cup of factory fresh tea.

**Lunch at a Restaurant –Colombo**

Afternoon undertake a City Tour of Colombo including a Buddhist Temple , a Hindu Kovil, Town Hall, BMICH, Galle Face Green , Old Parliament and Pettah and Fort Bazaar area and Shopping at Odel Unlimited and House of Fashion etc..

**Gala Dinner ( European Style ) with Music at Hotel .**

**Overnight at Galadari Hotel / Ceylon Continental / Galle Face Hotel or Similar – Colombo**
